- Has been roped off of, knows how to work cows
- Very fluent in lateral maneuvers/advanced movements including: Turn on the Forehand, Turn on the Haunches, Rollbacks, Side pass, Leg Yield, shoulder in, shoulder out, simple lead changes, flying lead changes.
- Knows all 4-H/WSCA game patterns
- Knows how to do most obstacles in a trail class. Good backing through an L, other configurations, can work a gate VERY well.
- Knows all of the showmanship maneuvers (pivot, walk, stop, trot, back, set-up)
